Life Line Screening

Chiquola will host a Life Line Screening preventive health event on Tuesday, October 20, 2020.

The *6 for Life Health Assessment* measures your risk of developing 6 chronic diseases, including heart disease, congestive heart failure, stroke, diabetes, COPD and lung cancer. A customized report will determine which risk factors contribute most to your disease risk and are within your control to change. Finger-stick blood tests along with biometric measurements are included with it. This is separate from vascular screenings.

get them filled and return to the church by Sunday morning, October 25. There is a listing of items that you are to put in them and an identification tag to denote boy or girl.

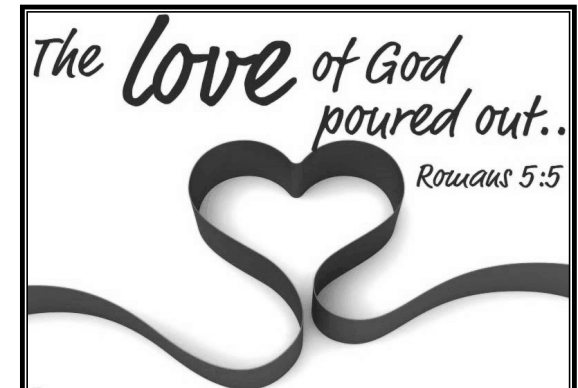
