Look at what Paul said as he closed his letter to the church at Ephesus: "Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen." Paul let the church know that peace and love came from the Father and the Son. He also assured them that God's grace was poured out to those who love the Lord. But, notice he did not say that people should just love the Lord. He said that they should love Him in sincerity. I think that has a unique look. Sincere love would be a love that is really appreciative, a love that is above all other loves.

In Colossians 1:18, we are told that Jesus is to have preeminence. That means He is to be above all. We are to have no one, or nothing, higher than Him. He is to be first in our lives.

Jesus said that no man can have two masters for he will hate one and love the other (Matt. 6:24).

Wouldn't it be great if we all had that sincere love for Jesus the Bible speaks of? Our lives would be so much better. Try loving Jesus with a sincere heart and watch how things change in your life. Only Jesus can make us what we need to be. Only through His love can we love each other the way He loves us, and intends for us to love. We need this sincere love in our lives!
