Missionary of the Week

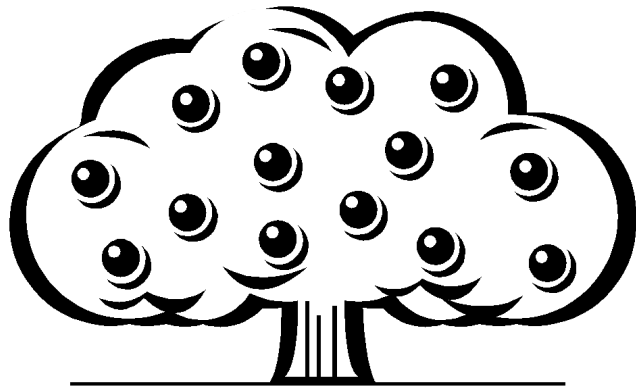
