



### Life Line Screening

On Friday, September 22, 2017, Life Line Screening and Health Support will be here on sight at Chiquola to perform screenings for those who would like to take advantage of this opportunity. They offer two packages. The first one covers Carotid Artery, Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm, Peripheral Arterial Disease, and Heart Rhythm. The cost of this one is normally \$139. The second package adds the Osteoporosis Risk Assessment. The cost of the second is \$149. Because we are offering it here at the church our members get a \$10 break on each package. The only thing is you have to sign up early for an appointment for that day. This is a chance you can get these checks at a discount price. None of us knows what is going on inside our bodies. This is an opportunity to have things checked out at an affordable price.

All you have to do is call the church office and let Kathrine know which package you want. The company will get back with you to set up your appointment. Call Kathrine before August 11, 2017. Remember, your cost will be either \$129 or \$139 – depending on which package you choose. Take advantage of this opportunity. It will give you a good piece of mind; maybe even save your life!
