II Corinthians 2:14-17 says, "Now thanks be unto God, which always causes us to triumph in Christ, and makes manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place. For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish: To the one we are the savour of death unto death; and to the other the savour of life unto life. And who is sufficient for these things? For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ."

Paul wrote this text when he was in Troas and the Lord opened a door for him to go to Macedonia. Paul saw the importance of following the Lord's leading in his life. He thanked God for leading him. He knew that God's leading is the place where he found victory; and that victory was in Jesus. He also knew what he had to share would bring others to the same end - triumphing in Christ!
