***Psalm 33: 9*** says this ***“For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.***

This past week summer began. The summer solstice marks the first day of summer in the Northern Hemisphere, bringing the longest day of the year, the shortest night and, in the northernmost Arctic, a midnight sun that shines around the clock. It coincides with the winter solstice in the Southern Hemisphere, which marks the year’s shortest day and the beginning of winter there. The term “solstice” comes from the Latin words “sol,” which means sun, and “sistere” which means to stop. The name reflects the fact that the sun seems to pause briefly when it reaches its annual southernmost or northernmost position in the sky before reversing direction.

So, I pose this question to you. Do you take the time to pause daily and enjoy God’s creations? ***Psalm 104:24 O Lord, how many are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all; The earth is full of Your possessions.***

Every day is a blessing from God, and He wants us to enjoy every bit of the creation that he has given us. It is time to take a moment out of your busy schedule to go outside and appreciate your surroundings. There are many ways to do this but the simplest and easiest way to enjoy nature and God’s creation is to take 30 minutes out of your busy schedule and go for a walk or just sit on the porch. I encourage you to not be distracted by your cell phone and really take the time to pray and notice the trees in your area, look up to the sky, listen to the birds and insects, observe all the beautiful colors and feel the warm sun in your face as you see God’s creation come to life in your mind and right before your very eyes.

***Revelation 4:11 “Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they existed, and were created.”*** By an act of His will God spoke everything into existence. Furthermore, every human being owes his or her existence and all the wonderful creations we enjoy from day to day to God’s innovative work.
