VISITATION WAS ESTABLISHED BY THE

HEAVENLY FATHER!! It originated in the mind of God and began in the Garden of Eden. As we see in Genesis 3:8. Adam and Eve heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the Garden. The God of heaven who had all the resources at his command chose to commune with those that he loved by "personal visitation." Visitation served as a contact between God and His people.
